Our first Festival was never planned to be an annual event but it was so much fun we did it again.

By the third year, we were getting requests from Arizonans to have booths to sell 'local' things and we started with four. By 1998 it was up to 19. Word spread quickly and by 2000 we were up to 53 in our ever-expanding nooks & corners of the streets and buildings.

When we moved to Tempe Beach Park we could expand again. Now we have 128 very competitive spots. Vendors come from four states plus Hawaii. One year brought American Samoa and Tahiti to join the mix.

We have 2 vendors that have been every year since 1998: Polynesian Designs and Ohana Ventures.
